# After the Warning Sounds?

- It depends on the emergency and direction from responders or the Incident Commander!



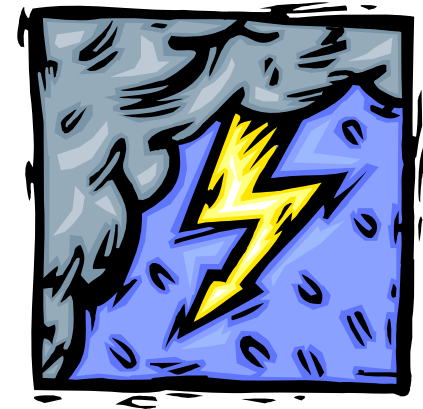
# Verification and Accounting

- Head counts
- Safe Areas
- Reporting counts
- Designated Gathering Points
- Evacuation Routes
- Backup Gathering Points



# Reverse Evacuation???
